## **Objective based programmes**

## SODARA also set the following objective based programmes in the Rules and Regulation at its foundation:

- 1. To undertake various schemes with or without the collaboration of the State and Central Governments and other Agencies for the eradication of illiteracy and for the realization of the objectives of SODARA through Non-formal and Formal Education and other suitable forms.
- 2. To provide a forum for research, training, coordination, collaboration and publication for the eradication of illiteracy, emancipation of the poor, minorities and weaker sections and for the promotion of developmental education and rural action.
- 3. To initiate programmes, projects and movements for the promotion of communal harmony, inter-faith dialogues and experiences, national integration, integration of spiritual aspirations with social work and to promote the study and practice of Rajya Yoga and other non-sectarian spiritual practices, especially meaningful to Indian culture without prejudice to article nos. 5 and 7 of the aims and objectives.
- 4. To promote comprehensive preventive and curative health and sanitation care with special attention to Nature Cure, Homeopathy, Yoga, Counselling, Holistic Programmes and other systems of indigenous medicines and to promote natural family planning.
- 5. To promote co-operative movement and self employment for the well-being of the poor, minorities, weaker sections through cottage/mini industries, scientific dry and wet farming, environmental protection, social forestry, use of non-conventional energy, rural housing, drinking water, irrigation schemes, vocationalisation of education, family saving schemes and other socio-economic developmental programmes.
- 6. Sanghams, cooperative societies, industrial co-operatives and associations etc. will be formed for the realisation of the aims and objectives of the Society.
- 7. To initiate, encourage and promote programmes, projects and movements to enable the people to avail the welfare schemes of the State and Central Governments and other Agencies and to meet their basic needs. SODARA may also work as a liaison body and to represent individuals or groups at various forums as and when required for the realization of the aims and objectives of the society.
- 8. To initiate, promote and encourage programmes, projects and movements for the involvement and participation of students, youth, volunteers, the poor, minorities and weaker sections, institutions, organisations, Government and other Agencies for the realisation of the aims and objectives. On behalf of the poorest sections in our mission may we invite you to be our partner in this mission.
